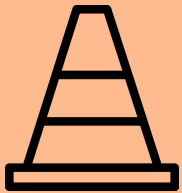
Get to know:

- Lack of willingness among potential clients to pay for services



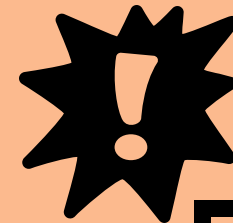
Recommended to:
