

Developing Climate Crisis & SRHR Programming

Terms of Reference

IPPF is clear on its global position and priorities for advocacy and engagement on the intersections of SRHR and the climate crisis. However further exploration is needed to develop programmatic support to MAs so they can engage more effectively on the SRHR and climate crisis nexus programmatically as well. Demand from Member Associations (MAs) for this support was highlighted in a recent survey with MAs which identified gaps in experience and knowledge on areas including how to integrate the linkages between climate and SRHR into projects and programmes, how to engage with partners for climate adaptation and/or resilience advocacy, and how to develop and implement policies and strategies to monitor their own environmental impact.

Purpose

IPPF is seeking a consultant to develop a programmatic approach which enable IPPF to support MAs to advocate, implement programmes and fundraise around the intersection between climate change and SRHR, and to monitor their own environmental impact.

The approaches will take into account factors including the context in which MAs are operating and ways in which climate change and SRHR can be integrated into MA service offers.

- Concept note with Proposed Programmatic Approach
